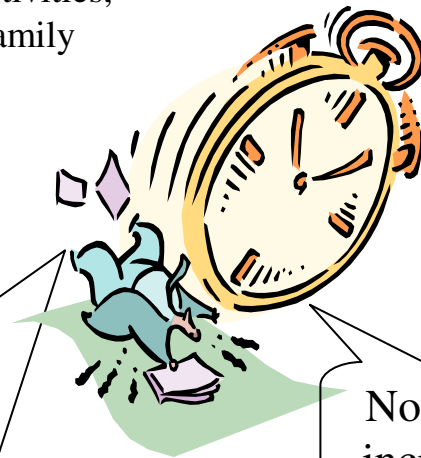

## Getting Here Is Easy . . .

**Driving** to the Daytona Beach is easy, as two of the state's major interstates intersect here - Interstate 95, and Interstate 4. Other major roads leading into the area are U.S. Highway 1; U.S. Highway 92; State Route 40, which connects to Interstate 75; and scenic Highway A1A along the Atlantic coastline. **Direct flights** to Daytona Beach International Airport from Atlanta, as well as the New York, Baltimore and Washington D.C. metro areas; depart daily via Delta, Continental, and AirTran airlines.
